A BRIEF HISTORY

Christ the King Inter College, T u n d l a , m a n a g e d a n d administered by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Agra Education Society, is a minority Christian Institution. It was established on 3rd July 1972 by late the Most Rev. Dr. Dominic Athaide (OFM Cap) the then Archbishop of Agra. The purpose of this school was to provide wholesome facilities to the students which will enable them to grow in holistic manner. The school was conducted in rented buildings till June 1978. The present premise was inaugurated in July 1978. In July 1985, the school was affiliated to the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi and the first batch of the ICSE came out in flying colours in May 1987.

The Most Rev. Dr. Albert D'Souza procured a new plot of land in September 2007 to relocate the primary section. On 15th August 2008 the first phase of Christ the King Primary School was commenced. On 3rd July 2009, the K.G. section and in July 2010 classes I to III were moved into the new building. The entire primary section from classes L.K.G. to V began to function in the new campus from April 2012. Since the school became ready for upgradation, in July 2010, the dream of Plus Two studies came true with the commencement of ISC Batch 2012 in Science and Commerce Stream. Currently, classes LKG to 100.

2012 in Science and Commerce Stream. Currently, classes LKG to VI are functioning in the primary wing while classes VII to XII functions in the senior wing.

In July 2022, our institution completed 50 years of its existence. It is a matter of huge gratification for us that our alumni hold prominent positions in diverse fields around the world. Our college has been serving since its inception as a crucible of learning and growth, empowering generations of young minds with knowledge, values and life skills that they need to thrive in this modern competitive world.

Admission Policy

NURSERY & LKG

Child's age for admission as on 1st April:

For Nursery : Child must be between 2 years 7 months to 3 years 6 months. For LKG : Child must be between 3 years 7 months to 4 years 6 months.

- Parents seeking admission of their wards in Nursery/LKG must register their ward's name and submit duly filled registration form in the school senior wing office on the said date and time.
- Dates for verification will be allotted to each child at the time of submitting the duly completed registration form. On the allotted dates for verification, the parents will come with the child.
- If there is more number of candidates (more than the available seats) found eligible for admission after the verification, then the required number will be finalized by lots which will be held internally.











- The list of the selected students will be displayed on the notice board/school website and their parents will be given time to deposit Admission fees and complete other admission formalities. Only the parent of the child and no other relatives will be able to complete the admission formalities.
- If the parent, whose child's name is there in the admission list, is unable to complete the formalities within the given dates, will forfeit the chance for admission. The management is not responsible for any unauthorized persons or activities in the name of the admission; no one is authorized to act on behalf of the school.
- o School does not provide transport facility.
- o It must be very clear that the parents who are seeking admission of their wards to Nursery/L.K.G. are fully aware of all the above conditions and have already read these conditions which were displayed on the school notice board much in advance.

Requirements (to be attached with Registration form): -

- Copy of the Birth Certificate from the Nagar Palika.
- 2. Copy of the Aadhar Card of Father, Mother & the child.
- 3. Address Proof (Photocopy of any one of these: Aadhar Card, Passport, Electricity Bill, Driving License or Voter ID)
- 4. Caste Certificate (In case the category is other than General) Attach the photo copy of either parent's caste certificate, in case child's caste certificate is not available.
- 5. Two passport size <u>latest</u> photographs of the child.
- 6. Two passport size <u>latest</u> photographs of the child with both the parents.

- Parents seeking admission for their wards should register against the declared vacancy in various classes. There will be an entrance test for such candidates based on the syllabus of the previous class he/she was studying. The minimum age of the child for admission in class I is 6 years. For above classes add one year each for every class. If a child is selected for admission after the Entrance test and interview, his/her Transfer Certificate in original from the previous school must be submitted within a prescribed period of time. Child seeking admission to Std I and above, who has not attended any school before will not be accepted for admission.
- O If the child is coming from a state other than Uttar Pradesh then a Transfer Certificate countersigned by the Education Department or by the Education Board (CISCE/CBSE) is compulsory. For classes VI & above Countersigned Transfer Certificate is compulsory for all. Qualified students shall be called with their testimonials and certificates for an interview before admission. The pupils appearing for the Interview should be accompanied by their parents themselves and not by any other relative.
- School does not provide transport facility.

DETAILS OF THE FEE STRUCTURE

The details of fees for the previous year, current year and the ensuing year are attached alongwith. All payments must be made according to the dates specified in the fee book. If the last date is a holiday payment must be made before that date. Parents are requested to keep the receipts issued to them and produce them as proof of payment, if needed. No child will be permitted to begin a new term unless all arrears due on his/her account have been cleared in full before the commencement of the new term. The fees will be deposited in the bank from 5th to 20th of the first month of every quarter. Failing to do so, the fine will be charged accordingly.





SPORTS, CO-CURRICULAR & EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

The school believes in Holistic education. Along with academics, it equally emphasizes on activities like Speech, Singing, Dancing, Craft, Drawing, Recitation, Fancy Dress, Debates, Essay writing, Declamation, Sports & Games etc. These activities are conducted throughout the year and the winners are awarded.
